Things You Might Not Know

- 1. Wilmer Steele of Sussex County, Delaware is often cited as the pioneer of the commercial broiler industry. In 1923 she raised a flock of 500 chicks intended to be sold for meat. Her little business was so profitable that, by 1926, Mrs. Steele was able to build a broiler house with a capacity of 10,000 birds.
- 2. A group of pigs is called a "sounder".
- 3. Pigs are considered the 4th most intelligent animal after chimpanzees, dolphins, and elephants.
- 4. Some breeds of chickens can lay colored eggs, the Ameraucanas and the Araucanas can lay eggs of green or blue color.
- 5. You can tell whether an egg is fresh or stale by dropping it in water. A fresh egg will sink and a stale egg will float.

Let's Talk Maintenance

Electric VHS Pump Motors

30HP and smaller - Grease top and bottom bearings every 300 hours.

40HP and larger - Check top bearing lubricating oil daily and change oil every 3 years or if oil becomes discolored due to moisture. Grease bottom bearing every 500 hours.





Right Angle Gear Drives

Check lubricating oil daily and change oil every 3 years or if oil becomes discolored due to moisture.

For Both VHS and Right Angle Gear Drives

Keep packing gland adjusted to 1-3 drops per second and make sure there is a rubber water slinger on the shaft between the packing gland and the bottom of the Right Angle Gear Drive or VHS motor to prevent water from following the shaft and entering the VHS motor or the Right Angle Gear Drive.

Recommended Oil for VHS Motors and Right Angle Gear Drives
VHS Motors - Texaco Regal 68 or equivalent
Right Angle Gear Drives - Texaco Regal R&O 150 or equivalent
